# WHAT TO LOOK FOR DURING YOUR VISIT

#### **RESIDENTS**

- Do residents look clean, well-dressed, and comfortable?
- Are they engaged in activities or socializing?
- Is their privacy respected (staff knock before entering, curtains used)?

#### **STAFF**

- Are staff warm, respectful, and responsive?
- Do they call residents by name?
- Is there enough staff visible and interacting with residents?

#### **RESIDENT ROOMS**

- Are rooms bright, clean, and personalized?
- Are rooms private or shared—and is there enough space?
- Do bathrooms have handrails and emergency call buttons?

#### **COMMON AREAS**

- Is the building clean and free of strong odors?
- Are halls and common spaces neat and easy to move through?
- Are there outdoor areas for residents to enjoy?

#### **MEALS**

- Does the dining area feel welcoming?
- Does the food look and smell appetizing?
- Do residents seem to enjoy their meals?
- Are staff helpful and attentive during meals?

# ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS

#### **COSTS & FEES**

- What services are included in the monthly rate?
- Are there extra charges (like for therapy, laundry, or snacks)?
- How often do fees change—and how much notice is given?
- Do you accept Medicare and/or Medicaid? How much is covered?

#### **MEDICAL CARE**

- Can residents keep their own doctor?
- Is there a doctor who visits regularly?
- How are emergencies handled—and how are families notified?
- Are memory care, rehab, or other special services available?

#### **MEALS**

- Does the dining area feel welcoming?
- Does the food look and smell appetizing?
- Are staff helpful and attentive during meals?

#### **ROOM & BED INFO**

- Are beds currently available? Is there a waiting list?
- What do I need to apply or hold a room?
- Will my loved one have a private room or share?

#### **DAILY LIFE**

- What meals and snacks are served each day?
- Can residents make choices about food or meal times?
- What types of activities are offered?
- Are there events for residents who are less mobile?

#### **EXTRAS & PERSONAL TOUCHES**

- Is laundry included?
- Can residents bring personal items or furniture?
- Are pets allowed to visit or stay?
- Are religious or spiritual needs supported?
